Day 1	<p><b>Kuala Lumpur – Transit</b></p> <p>Meet at Kuala Lumpur International Airport 1 for departure to Casablanca, Morocco.</p> <p>Meals: Meals on board</p>
Day 2	<p><b>Transit - Casablanca - Marrakesh (244km, 3.5 hrs)</b></p> <p>Meet and greet at Mohammed V Aeroport, Casablanca by our Morocco2u national guide.</p> <p>We will start our journey visiting the <a href="#">Hassan II Mosque</a>, one of the modern mosques in the world and the only mosque in Morocco which opens to non-Muslim for visit. This majestic architecture marvel which part sit on the Atlantic Ocean and part on land being completed in 1993 having the second tallest minaret in the world with a laser beaming directly towards Mecca.</p> <p>After lunch, we will travel to the red city, Marrakesh.</p> <div data-bbox="352 936 1329 1240" style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">   </div> <p>Meals: Local Lunch, Hotel Dinner            Hotel: Hotel Meriem 4**** or similar</p>
Day 3	<p><b>Marrakesh</b></p> <p>Marrakesh is a former imperial city of Morocco and its medina was listed as the UNESCO World Heritage. It was known as the red city because of its buildings and ramparts of beaten clay. After breakfast, we will visit <a href="#">Koutoubia Mosque</a>, the largest mosque in Marrakesh built during the 12<sup>th</sup> century, located in the heart of the city. Also, the 19th century largest and most luxurious palace, <a href="#">Bahia Palace</a>, one of the masterpieces of Moroccan architecture. Experience the beautiful garden, <a href="#">Majorelle Garden</a> - An Artist's Dream and Botanical Paradise. At the evening, free &amp; easy at the largest traditional market <a href="#">Jemaa El Fna</a> when the squares are filled up with food stands, fortune teller, musician, artist etc.</p> <div data-bbox="357 1727 1437 1980" style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">    </div> <p>Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch, Local Dinner            Hotel: Hotel Meriem 4**** or similar</p>

<p>Day 4</p>	<p><b>Marrakesh - Ouarzazate (194km, 4hrs)</b></p> <p>After breakfast, we will depart to Ouarzazate, a mini Hollywood of Morocco as all of the things to do in Ouarzazate have some connection to a film set. Over the years, the city has served as a shooting location for many blockbuster movies, including the Lawrence of Arabia, Game of Thrones, Gladiator and etc. Along the way enjoy the changing view from the low reddish land of modern town to the view of the Atlas mountain via the mountain pass; Tizi n Tichka pass which is about 2260 above sea level.</p> <p><u><a href="#">Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou</a></u>: A UNESCO world heritage site since 1987, was a group of earthen buildings surrounded by high walls, a traditional pre-Saharan habitat. Four families are currently living inside the fortress. While the best thing to do here is walking around the town to admire the mud-brick architecture and hike to the top where you can get a spectacular view.</p> <p><u><a href="#">Atlas Film Studio</a></u>: Explore the largest film studio in the world to re-experience Hollywood movies. The studio covers more than 322,000 square feet of desert with several old movie sets.</p> <p><u><a href="#">Argan Oil Womens Cooperative</a></u>: Argan oil are heavily used by the local Amazigh people. Have a first-hand view of how the Argan oil is being produce mainly by hand.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">   </div> <p>Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch, Hotel Dinner            Hotel: Hotel Farah Al Janoub 4**** or similar</p>
<p>Day 5</p>	<p><b>Ouarzazate – Rose Valley (95km, 1.5hrs) – Todra Gorge (80km, 1.5hrs) - Merzouga (200km, 3hrs)</b></p> <p>Journey to the Sahara Desert. Our drive will reach <u><a href="#">Todra Gorge</a></u>, the majestic rocky mountain that has been halved by the flowing Todra river. We will walk along the river for one of the most dramatic views in the country and feel the amazing height of the gorge. Stop for a lunch before following the route of a thousand kasbah to Merzouga, the entrance gateway to the Sahara Desert. En route we will pass by the rose valley. Of course, only during the summer you will be able to smell the aroma of the roses.</p> <p>Upon arrival, you will be guided to mount your camel which will be led by a Berber's camel man. This slow and buoyant ride across the sand dunes provides us the opportunity to experience the great Sahara sunset. Our desert <u><a href="#">camel ride</a></u> will take us about 45 min before we reach our gorgeous campsite. Upon reaching our camp, relax and freshen up before a traditional dinner is served. Berber's hypnotic drum performance will entertain you too. Let be here for the desert experience, a chance to pretend we were the nomads.</p>

<p>Day 6</p>	<p><b>Merzouga - Midelt (265km, 4hrs) - Ifrane (136km, 2hrs) - Fes (70km, 1hr)</b></p> <p>Waking up and perched on top of the dunes, watched as gilded rays slowly swelled and then spilled over the horizon. The beauty of the great Sahara sunrise. After breakfast, We will start our journey to the oldest imperial city of Morocco, Fes. En route, we will stop by for a Lunch in Midelt, a market town set within the high plains between the Middle and High Atlas mountain ranges. Travelling through the highland and valley, you are presented with nature beauty of great valley open up to oasis view along the way.</p> <p>Continuing our journey to the famous Swiss influence resort-town, Ifrane. Also the only town in Morocco experiences snow during winter. Famous for its pines tree, ski slope and relaxing cafe for a weekend gateway. The stone sculpture is a well-known landmark, carved by a German soldier during WWII (or according to the local legend is to commemorate the last wild Atlas lion) Nevertheless, having your picture taken with the lion is something of a ritual for visitors.</p>  <p>Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch, Hotel Dinner</p> <p>Hotel: Hotel Escale 4**** or similar</p>
<p>Day 7</p>	<p><b>Fes - Chefchaouen (196km, 4hrs)</b></p> <p>Fes is the largest pedestrian city in the world and also heart of the Morocco's culture and spirituality. Built in the 9th century, it brings each visitor the sense of going back in time. With it olden architecture, narrow donkey pathway and horse and cart, the extensive selection of Moroccan's traditional art and craft, you witness a piece of history suspended in time.</p> <p>After breakfast, start our day with an in-depth view and knowledge of the ancient craft of the <a href="#">Zellige</a>. Visit the <a href="#">Royal Palace</a> before proceeding to the main entrance of the medina, <a href="#">Bab Boujloud</a> also known as the blue gate (the most famous gate in Morocco). Roaming through the winding and narrow streets to find for the world oldest and continually operating university – <a href="#">al-Qarawiyyin Mosque</a>; admire the beautiful Marinid architecture – <a href="#">Madrassa Bou Inania</a> and the largest and best-known tannery in the heart of the souk - <a href="#">Chouara Tannery</a>. Enjoy our lunch in the medina before we continue our journey to the charming blue city of Chefchaoune.</p>

<p>Day 8</p>	<p><b>Chefchaouen - Rabat (251km, 4hrs) - Casablanca (88km, 1hr)</b></p> <p>Today we will explore this tiny city, known as Morocco "<u>blue pearl</u>" or the <u>blue city</u> rested under the Rif mountain. It cool beauty of all hue blue and white calm our soul as we walk and climb on the cobble narrow alley. The Berber's tribe people can be seen wearing cotton clothing with hat of bright decorated thread. Goat cheese is very famous here, give it a try.</p> <p>After lunch, we drive to the capital of Morocco, Rabat. Also one of the country's four imperial cities. Visit the <u>Hassan Tower</u>, which was intended to be finished as the tallest minaret and mosque in the world in 12th century. However, the construction was stopped after the sultan died. Just across the unfinished ruins stands the striking <u>Mausoleum of Mohammed V.</u></p>  <p>Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch, Hotel Dinner</p> <p>Hotel: Hotel Oum Palace 4**** or similar</p>
<p>Day 9</p>	<p><b>Casablanca – Kuala Lumpur</b></p> <p>After breakfast, transfer to airport.</p> <p>Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch</p> <p>Hotel: -</p>

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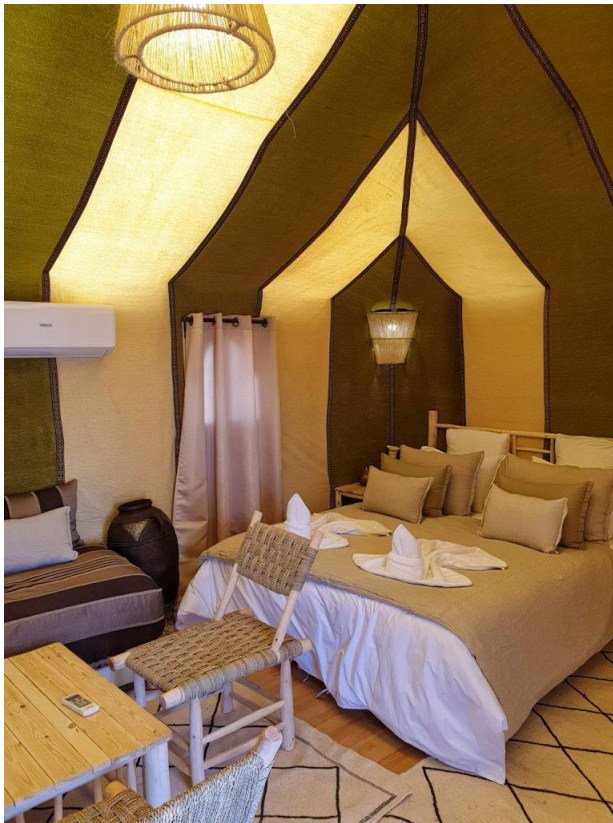
