This majestic architecture marvel which part sit on the Atlantic Ocean and part on land being completed in 1993 having the second tallest minaret in the world with a laser beaming directly towards Mecca. |

| | Marrakesh is a former imperial city of Morocco and its medina was listed as the UNESCO World Heritage. It was known as the red city because of its buildings and ramparts of beaten clay. After breakfast, we will visit <u>Koutoubia Mosque</u> , the largest mosque in Marrakesh built during the 12 th century, located in the heart of the city. Also, the 19th century largest and most luxurious palace, <u>Bahia Palace</u> , one of the masterpieces of Moroccan architecture. Experience the beautiful garden, <u>Majorelle Garden</u> - An Artist's Dream and Botanical Paradise. At the evening, free & easy at the largest traditional market Jemaa El Fna when the squares are filled up with food stands, fortune teller, musician, artist etc. |

| | After breakfast, we will depart to Ouarzazate, a mini Hollywood of Morocco as all of the things to do in Ourzazate have some connection to a film set. Over the years, the city has served as a shooting location for many blockbuster movies, including the Lawrence of Arabia, Game of Thrones, Gladiator and etc. Along the way enjoy the changing view from the low reddish land of modern town to the view of the Atlas mountain via the mountain pass; Tizi n Tichka pass which is about 2260 above sea level. Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou: A UNESCO world heritage site since 1987, was a group of earthern buildings surrounded by high walls, a traditional pre-Saharan habitat. Four families are currently living inside the fortress. While the best thing to do here is walking around the town to admire the mud-brick architecture and hike to the top where you can get a spectacular view. |
| | <u>Atlas Film Studio</u>: Explore the largest film studio in the world to re-experience Hollywood movies. The studio covers more than 322,000 square feet of desert with several old movie sets. <u>Argan Oil Womens Cooperative</u>: Argan oil are heavily used by the local Amazigh people. Have a first-hand view of how the Argan oil is being produce mainly by hand. |

| Day 5 | Hotel: Hotel Farah Al Janoub 4**** or similar Ourzazate – Rose Valley (95km, 1.5hrs) – Todra Gorge (80km, 1.5hrs) - Merzouga (200km, 3hrs) Journey to the Sahara Desert. Our drive will reach Todra Gorge, the majestic rocky mountain that has been halve by the flowing Todra river. We will walk along the river for one of the most dramatic views in the country and feel the amazing height of the gorge. Stop for a lunch before following the route of a thousand kasbah to Merzouga, the entrance gateway to the Sahara Desert. En route we will pass by the rose valley. Of |



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course, only during the summer you will be able to smell the aroma of the roses. Upon arrival, you will be guide to mount your camel which will be led by a Berber's camel man. This slow and buoyancy ride across the sand dunes provide us the opportunity to experience the great Sahara sunset. Our desert camel ride will take us about 45 min before we reach our gorgeous campsite. Upon reaching our camp, a welcome cocktail will be expecting you, consisting of Moroccan cookies, dates, and tea. Berber's hypnotic drum performance will entertain you too, following will be a typical Moroccan dinner. Let be here for the desert experience, a chance to pretend we were the nomads. Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch, Berbers' Dinner Hotel: Sahara Desert Luxury Camp with private bathroom Explore Merzouga: 4x4 Adventure Desert Day Tour Day 6 Today, we will have a complete exploration of the marvel desert region by 4x4. We will make a circuit of the desert dunes where you will have the opportunity for a closer contact with the Berber culture by visiting the nomad's family, at the same time be amazed by the changing contrast of desert. We will also visit the "black village", Khamlia to enjoy a cup of tea with beautiful Gnawa music. En route, we will stop by at the oasis where fossils quarries still present in the area. At the afternoon, we have lunch in Rissani, the closest town to Merzouga. After an authentic lunch, we continue to visit the famous Rissani market which only opens at certain days (Not guaranteed). Before heading back to the hotel, we will visit the little remains of the once –great city of Sijilmassa. Back to the 8th century, it was major merchant city for the trans-Saharan trade. Meals: Hotel Breakfast, Local Lunch, Berbers' Dinner Hotel: Auberge Du Sud Sand Dunes Hotel Merzouga - Midelt (265km, 4hrs) - Ifrane (136km, 2hrs) - Fes (70km, 1hr) Day 7 Waking up and perched on top of the dunes, watched as gilded rays slowly swelled and then spilled over the horizon. The beauty of the great Sahara sunrise. After breakfast, We will start our journey to the oldest imperial city of Morocco, Fes. En route, we will stop by for a Lunch in Midelt, a market town set within the high plains between the Middle and High Atlas mountain ranges. Travelling through the highland and valley, you are presented with nature beauty of great valley open up to oasis view along the way. Continuing our journey to the famous Swiss influence resort-town, Ifrane. Also the only



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| | town in Morocco experiences snow during winter. Famous for its pines tree, ski slope and relaxing cafe for a weekend gateway. The stone sculpture is a well-known landmark, carved by a German soldier during WWII (or according to the local legend is to commemorate the last wild Atlas lion) Nevertheless, having your picture taken with the lion is something of a ritual for visitors. |

With it olden architecture, narrow donkey pathway and horse and cart, the extensive selection of Moroccan's traditional art and craft, you witness a piece of history suspended in time. |

Visit the Royal Palace before proceeding to the main entrance of the medina, Bab Boujloud also known as the blue gate (the most famous gate in Morocco). Roaming through the winding and narrow streets to find for the world oldest and continually operating university – al-Qarawiyyin Mosque; admire the beautiful Marinid architecture – Madrassa Bou Inania and the largest and best-known tannery in the heart of the souk - Chouara Tannery. Enjoy our lunch in the medina before we continue our journey to the charming blue city of Chefchaoune. |
